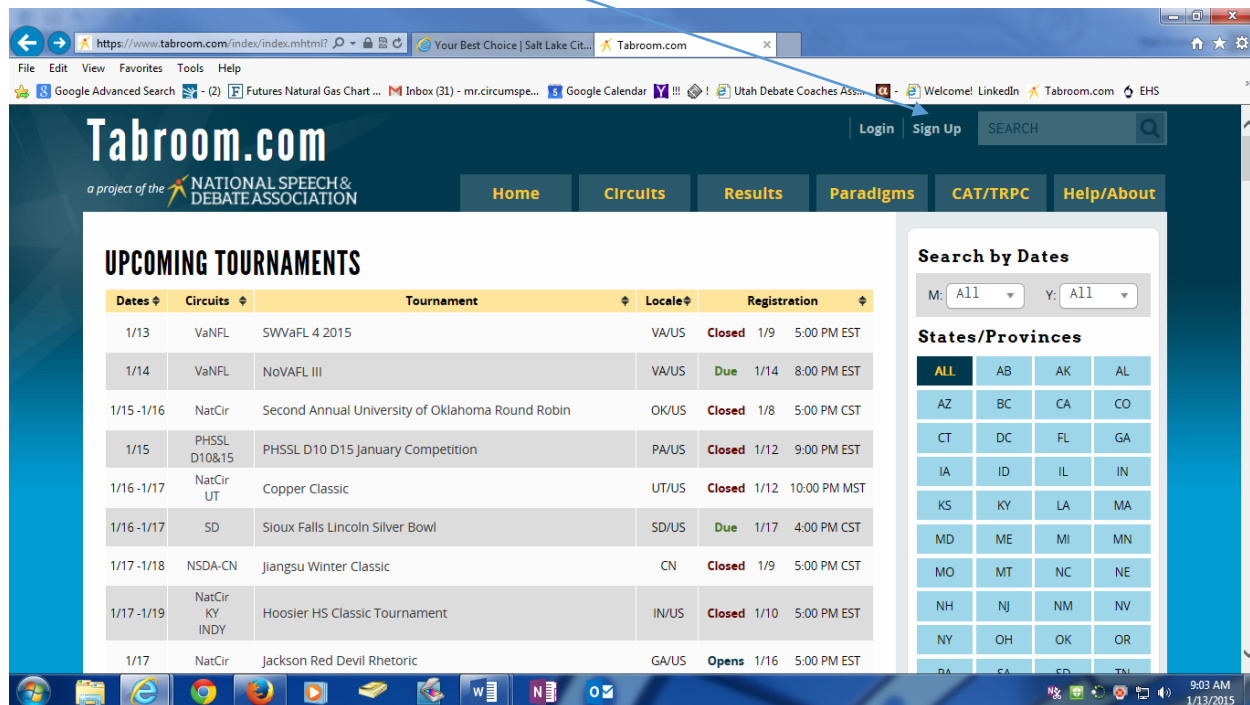


Please be sure to create a Tab Room account before the event.

Here is how to do it:

Step 1: open your Internet browser and navigate to: **tabroom.com**

Step 2: Click on **Sign Up**



Step 3:

The following form will be displayed.

Be sure to enter an E-mail address.

Make your password something easy, like 123456, or something you already use.

After you enter the information, remember to click the **Create Account** button at the bottom of the screen (you might have to scroll down to see it).

About your account

We ask for your cell number & provider so you can use the text messaging service to find out pairings and results at your tournaments. Just select "Landline" if you do not want to get these texts.

You can turn off email notices at any time; just log into your Tabroom account, click on Account in the top right, and select "No Emails". This will turn off reminders, pairing notices, and tournament administrator emails.

Tabroom is a free service for the world's debate communities developed by Chris Palmer and Jon Brusckva. Work on Tabroom has been supported by the National Speech and Debate Association, AskOnline, Summit Debate, The Open Society Foundations, and California State University at Fullerton.

Step 4:

Once your account is created, your coach will assign you to a particular event (several days before the event). If you are new to tabroom, please come a little early to the event, and talk to someone for help. Your assignments will be delivered within the tabroom.com web site.

You can view your assignments by logging into your account, then clicking on the name of the tournament for which you are judging. Once you see how to navigate around tabroom, you will realize that it is kind of straight forward. You are welcome to ask for some help, so feel free to ask for some guidance.

Once your account is set up, please notify your coach as soon as possible with your contact information including the E-mail address you used to create your account. Your coach will link you as a judge (or contestant) to a particular event (LD, PF, etc.).
